




DSEI's daily waterborne demonstrations are a visitor
East Terrace at DSEI 2021 was an outdoor showcase of the latest equipment and capabilities from exhibiting companies. This year's display Systems, the most modern, wheeled 155/52 calibre system in operation today. Among the other exhibits was Saab's multi-mission surveillance radar, the Giraffe 1x, and the Inflatable Walls Training System from Survitec.

Content Programme

Under the theme of Integrated Responses to Future Threats, the DSEI 2021 Content Programme explored the impact of multi-domain integration on future operational requirements.

DSEI Connect - NEW FOR 2021

New for 2021, the online platform and app, DSEI Connect was launched to complement the live event and to enable those who were unable to attend in person to fully participate. Users were able to catch up with keynotes and seminar content from the live event, browse supply chain listings and arrange virtual or in-person meetings with suppliers or relevant buyers using the built-in meetings tool, MeetMe.









British military jet developer AERALIS announced the development of its pioneering modular military aircraft, entering a landmark Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Rolls-Royce to meet the company's propulsion requirements.



Raytheon UK announced a partnership with the UK MoD to provide a High Energy Laser Weapon System (HELWS). A demonstrator of the system will be installed on the UK Wolfhound land vehicle and provided the MoD for a six-month trial from Spring 2023.



The Defence Science and Technology Laboratory (Dstl) announced a study into Uncrewed Ground Vehicle (UGV) concepts to explore cost effective solutions to protect UGVs from threat and provide specific armour and technology that will ensure high levels of mobility, survivability and mission availability to support crewed platforms in battlefield warfare.



The British Army announced the electrification of its battlefield vehicles to focus on an increase in the use of batteries, sustainable energy and hybrid electric drive technologies across its vehicle fleet.
